



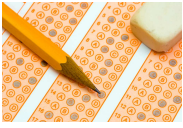

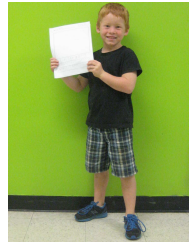
## Great Grants

*I liked the music and the instruments. There were two drums and one tuba and the most awesome instruments, the trumpets.* Steven

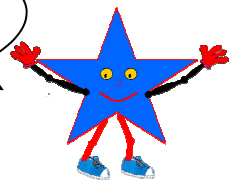
*It was really fun. They are from New Orleans. They have been together for 17 years this November.* Sawyer
