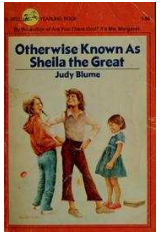
## 3/4 Reviews the play Otherwise Know as Sheila the Great

*Two things I learned about Sheila the Great is that you never give up trying and don't lie. — Trista*

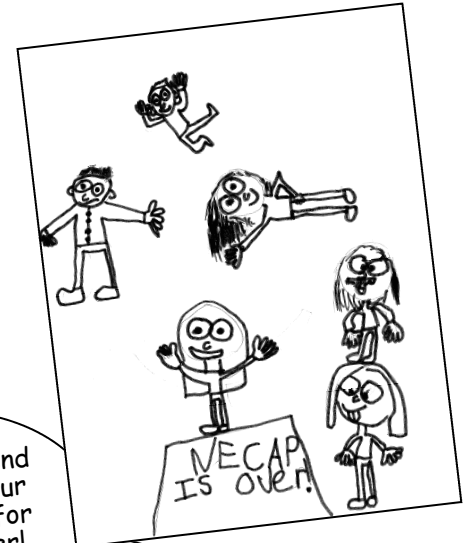

## New Drop-off/Pick-up Traffic Pattern Coming...

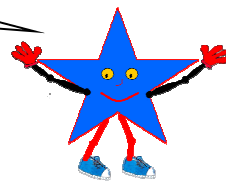
Please look out for information coming home soon about a new traffic pattern for the drop-off and pick-up of students. A letter and map of the pattern will be ready in about a week.
